From the Pastor's Desk

Last Sunday, Jesus cleansed the temple of Jerusalem. He made a whip out of cord and drove out the animals and the money changers. He wanted to restore his Father's house to its quiet, prayerful, life-giving origins. When asked, "What sign can You show us for doing this?" Jesus replied, "Destroy this temple and I will raise it up on the third day." Jesus was clearly making a reference to his own bodily resurrection from the tomb on Easter. By identifying himself as a temple, Jesus raises our dignity as his brothers and sisters to a new awareness. The Holy Spirit, God himself, dwells in his disciples.

St. Paul refers to this when he reminds us that we are all temples of the Holy Spirit (1Corinthians 6). Lent is that season of self-preparation for the celebration of Holy Week and Easter. We are reminded of the importance of inviting Jesus into our hearts, so that He may purify us, driving out all the profanations and distortions caused by our selfishness and sin. This inner act of purification takes place in the sacrament of Penance. After prayerful examination of conscience, we can confess our sins to the priest who stands in the person of Christ. We express our contrition which includes a firm resolution with God's grace to sin no more. Then we are once again brought to the life-giving moment of our baptism, restored anew as the purified Temple of the Holy Spirit.




