This Sunday, because we have the privilege of a member of the elect (someone who will be baptized, confirmed and receive 1st Eucharist at the Easter Vigil) among us, we celebrate the 1st of the 3 Scrutinies; and so, at the 12NN Mass, the scripture readings will be taken from Year A rather than B, our current year. At the noon Mass, the Gospel will be from John 4, the story of the woman at the well. Here is something for all of us to consider this week: Why did the Samaritan woman come to draw water at noon, the hottest time of the day? Did she want to avoid the times the other women in town came to the well? What are the places in my life where I am embarrassed, where I avoid interaction with others? What are the noon day wells of my life? Can I imagine Jesus approaching me there?
