
From the desk of the Pastoral Associate Mrs. Linda Muldoon

Such contrast today between the reading from Isaiah, Psalm 23, and St. Paul's letter to the Philippians with our Gospel from Matthew. How does God speak to us in this arrangement of readings? We have the Lord "providing for all people" and "saving us." We have refreshment, guidance, accompaniment, anointing. We have humility, abundance, and full supply of what is needed. Sounds like we're all set... But then the Gospel tells us, "The feast is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy to come." The longer option goes on to describe "wailing and grinding of teeth." Maybe we're not so all set...

My reflecting led me back to today's response in Psalm 23: "I shall live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life." That's the house I want to live in, where God provides for me and gives to me a full supply of all that is needed. But wait... our God is a God of relationship! Relationships require



the investment of all parties. Have I invited God into my house? What in my actual house suggests that God dwells there? What in my mind and heart and soul reflects God's presence? Is God invited into my relationships with family, friends, and co-workers? When I enter God's house at St. Francis or St. Clare or wherever I attend Mass, is my "house" worthy to receive the Eucharist? Time for some fall cleaning...


