As we did last year all students will remain in their school uniforms for rehearsals and must bring their own snack to eat at break time.

No one is allowed to leave the school to purchase snacks or drinks.

All students are to report directly to the cafeteria at dismissal.

Only bottled water will be allowed during rehearsal.

No power drinks, mineral waters or sodas!

Therefore, we ask you to please read, understand and accept the following agreement.

PARENTS - Please review the following with your child.

In all Drama Club activities and rehearsals I will:

- Give, earn and keep respect;
- Listen:
- · Support and encourage other members;
- Do the right thing;
- Treat others as I want to be treated;
- Tell the teacher if there is a problem;
- Bring script, pencil, and water each week to rehearsal.



- Demonstrate my best behavior at each rehearsal and performance. I understand that if my behavior is disruptive, unsafe or disrespectful in any way, I will be asked to leave the program.
- Keep up with all my schoolwork.
- Keep all electronic devices in my backpack during all activities and rehearsals.
- Be prepared for rehearsals.
- If I am hungry afterschool and need to eat a snack it is my responsibility to provide one.
- Attend all rehearsals. Missing rehearsals may result in my losing my part.
- If I audition for and am cast in a 'lead' role I will make a commitment to 1) attend all rehearsals and learn my lines and 2) not quit the program once I am cast in that role.
- During the final weeks before the production I agree to:
 - 1. Know all lines, music, blocking and dances. I understand that memorization is my homework!
 - 2. Attend all tech and dress rehearsals before the production.

In order to have a quality show and be fair to all cast members a commitment to be at rehearsal is important. Please consider this when deciding to participate in this and other extra-curricular activities. Please inform the director of any conflicting events as soon as possible.

As a parent I agree to the following:
