Middle School **Math Expectations**

Quality of Work

All math work should be done in pencil. All assignments given should also have work attached to their answers. No math is done mentally unless I have given permission to the class. When work is attached to an assignment, it should be done neatly so I can easily see it and check it if need be.

Homework

Homework is assigned every night except for Friday. It will be a review of that day's lesson and so it should be understood and completed that night. I do expect students to complete their homework every night. If a student spends a half hour attempting their homework and does not understand it, I will accept a note from the parent stating that.

As stated in the middle school policies, a completed homework assignment will be given two points. An incomplete assignment, or a math assignment with no work attached, will be given one point. A missing assignment will be given zero points.

Tests/Quizzes

There will be two quizzes in a chapter and one test at the end of the chapter. When studying for a quiz or a test, please remember that math is different than other subjects in school because it is not one that can be studied and learned before a quiz. Math is a practice subject that needs to be drilled and practiced nightly. That is why I do give nightly homework. Before a quiz or a test, we will spend class time going over all of the different skills we have learned. I will answer any questions students may have and then I expect students to go home and practice on their own. If I feel a student may need extra help before a test, I will contact the parent to see if he/she agrees and we can set up a time. Also, if a parent feels their child needs extra help, he/she can contact me and again, we can set up a time.

Extra Help

Extra help, as stated above, can be determined if felt it is needed by a parent or by me.
